***DO NOT APPLY IF YOU ARE AN ACTIVE POLL WORKER WITH WHITE COUNTY**

Under the direction of the Elections Supervisor and the Election Board, the Poll Workers ensure the eligibility of voters and explain voting procedures to ensure the conduct of a fair and accurate election.

POLL WORKER REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a U.S. Citizen
- Must be a current White County Resident JOB OPPORTUNITIES
- Must be a minimum 16 years of age
- Must have the ability to read/write/speak the English language
- Must be able to work a full day at the polls, Election Days are approximately 14 hour days
- Basic computer skills are helpful
- Must not hold a current Public Office position
- Is not a parent, spouse, child, brother, sister, father-in-law, mother-in-law, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, brother-in-law or sister-in-law of a candidate whose name appears on the ballot in the precinct in which the poll worker will be assigned during a primary or election
- Must not have ever been convicted of a felony

POLL WORKER RESPONSABILITIES

- All Poll Workers, once selected, must attend a four-hour training on policy, procedures, and election equipment.
- Poll Managers and Assistant Managers must work together the day before the election to set-up the polling precinct and prepare for Election Day.
- You may work during Advanced Voting or Election Day or both.
- On Election Day, every Poll Worker must arrive at their assigned polling location at 6:00am and must be prepared to work until every citizen of White County has an opportunity to vote and the precinct is packed up. (Approximately 14 hours)

POLL WORKER POSITIONS

1. MANAGER

The Precinct Manager serves as the Subject Matter Expert on Election Policies and Procedures for their selected precinct. The fundamental duty is to ensure that their precinct is in compliance with the rules and regulations as prescribed in the Official Code of Georgia Annotated Manual and the White County Election Procedures.

2. ASSISTANT MANAGER

The Assistant Manager serves as the immediate back up of the Precinct Manager. The Assistant Manager also serves as the Subject Matter Expert on Election Policies and Procedures for their selected precinct. The fundamental duty is to ensure that their precinct is in compliance with the rules and regulations as prescribed in the Official Code of Georgia Annotated Manual and the White County Election Procedures.

3. CLERK

The Poll Worker serves as the responsible party who searches the precinct listing of registered voters through the Poll Pad to ensure voters are eligible to cast their ballot on the Ballot Marking Device (BMD). They ensure the voters complete the Voter's Certificate (if necessary), showed the appropriate identification, and has returned the green Voter Access card upon completion of voting and issues every voter an "I'M A GEORGIA VOTER" Sticker.

COMPENSATION

Poll Official compensation will be based on specific positions/roles and will be paid at Per Diem (flat-rate):

All compensation will be paid at the **conclusion of each election**.

Election Day

- a. Manager – \$260.00
- b. Assistant Manager - \$245.00
- c. Poll Worker – \$180.00

Advanced Voting (will be scheduled as ½ days)

- a. Manager – \$70.50
- b. Assistant Manager - \$66.50
- c. Poll Worker – \$57.00

In-Person Training - \$25

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. The above compensation includes precinct setup the day before Election Day.
2. All Advanced Voting hours will be scheduled as ½ days.
3. Poll workers are responsible for signing-in (as instructed by staff) for training, set up, and for Election Day – in order for their compensation to be processed.
4. Additional training will be held for Managers and Assistant Managers.

NOTICE: The recruitment, selection, appointment, and promotion of employees shall be in such a manner as to promote equal employment for all persons without regard to race, age, color, creed, religion, ancestry, sex, national origin, physical handicap, or political affiliation.
