

Absentee by Mail Voting

Due to changes with the passing of The Election Integrity Act of 2021, Absentee By Mail (ABM) voting has changed. *Please read this in its entirety to insure you have a clear understanding of the changes and new requirements.*

- Voters can request an absentee ballot <u>78 days before an election</u> without providing a reason. <u>The last day to submit an absentee application is 11 days prior to the election</u>.
 - •Any person applying for an Absentee By Mail (ABM) ballot shall make application in writing on the form made available by the Secretary of State.

- •In order to confirm the identity of the voter, the following shall be provided:
 - his or her name
 - date of birth
 - address as registered
 - address where the elector wishes the ballot to be mailed, and
 - the number of his or her Georgia driver's license or identification

If such elector does not have a Georgia driver's license or identification card, the elector must provide a copy of a form of identification listed in subsection (c) of Code Section 21-2-417.

- a current utility bill
- bank statement
- government check
- o paycheck
- other government document that shows the name and address of such elector
