TERMINATION OF LOCAL ORDERS REGARDING COVID PRECAUTION PROCEDURES

On, August 23, 2021 this Court, acting in his capacity as Chief Superior Court Judge of the Enotah Judicial Circuit did order the use of personal protective mask/face coverings, temperature screenings and maintaining a 6ft social distance to enter and while within the Courthouse. This order was issued in response to a sudden tremendous increase in COVID cases within all 4 Counties and the surrounding areas. These numbers have now significantly decreased. THEREFORE,

MASK

ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED. **However,** if anyone entering the building feels more comfortable wearing their mask or face covering, they shall be welcome to do so.

TEMPERATURE SCREENINGS

Temperature Screenings will NO LONGER be required.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

Social Distancing is NO LONGER required in the Courtrooms or other areas within the Courthouse.

COMMON SENSE – PRACTICAL PRECAUTIONS

Everyone is reminded to use common sense, and to apply practical precautions. Persons experiencing a fever, sore throat, shortness of breath, nausea and/or other similar symptoms should **NOT** come into the Courthouse. If your presence has been requested/demanded by a Court and you are experiencing these symptoms please contact your Attorney or the Court that has requested/demanded your presence by phone prior to reporting.

Also, while no longer required GOOD personal hygiene, hand washing, use of hand sanitizer etc. is still a good practice to have.

Posted orders requiring masks/face coverings, social distancing and similar COVID related precaution procedures are ordered removed from public posting throughout the Courthouse.

This new order shall be posted for public viewing for a period of 30 days from the date of this order.
