

WCPRD Youth Sports All-Star Program Procedures

1) Eligibility

- a) The participant must reside full-time in White County or attend a White County School to be eligible for all-star selection.

2) All-Star Coaching Selection

- a) For each eligible age group, the coach with the most wins will be named the head coach of said all-star team. If for some reason the coach named is unwilling, unable, or ineligible to coach said team, that coach's assistant coach will be chosen to coach said team. If the assistant coach from the team with the best record is unwilling, unable, or ineligible to coach said team, the head coach from the team with the second highest winning record will be asked to coach said team. This process will continue on until a coach is secured. WCPRD reserves the right to appoint a coach in warranted circumstances.

3) Nomination and Selection Process

- a) For each eligible age group, coaches will meet with WCPRD staff where coaches will nominate players from their team that they deem a good candidate for the all-star team in that division.
- b) After player are nominated from each team, WCPRD staff and league coaches will discuss each nominated player.
- c) Basketball
 - a. The head coaches of each age group will select a maximum of 10 players. (Note: WCRD has zero input on who makes the all-star team, this is up to the coaches)
 - b. Three alternates will be chosen, but will only be contacted in the event a player on the official all-star roster is unable to participate.
- d) Baseball/Softball
 - a. The head coaches of each age group will select a maximum of 15 players. (Note: WCRD has zero input on who makes the all-star team, this is up to the coaches)
 - b. Three alternates will be chosen, but will only be contacted in the event a player on the official roster is unable to participate.
- e) WCRD will attempt to have at least one player selected from each team in every age group. However, in the event that all coaches unanimously agree to not select a player from a certain team, then it will be allowed to not select a player from said team.

4) Playing Time

- a) There are no playing time requirements in all-stars.
