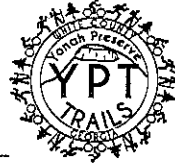


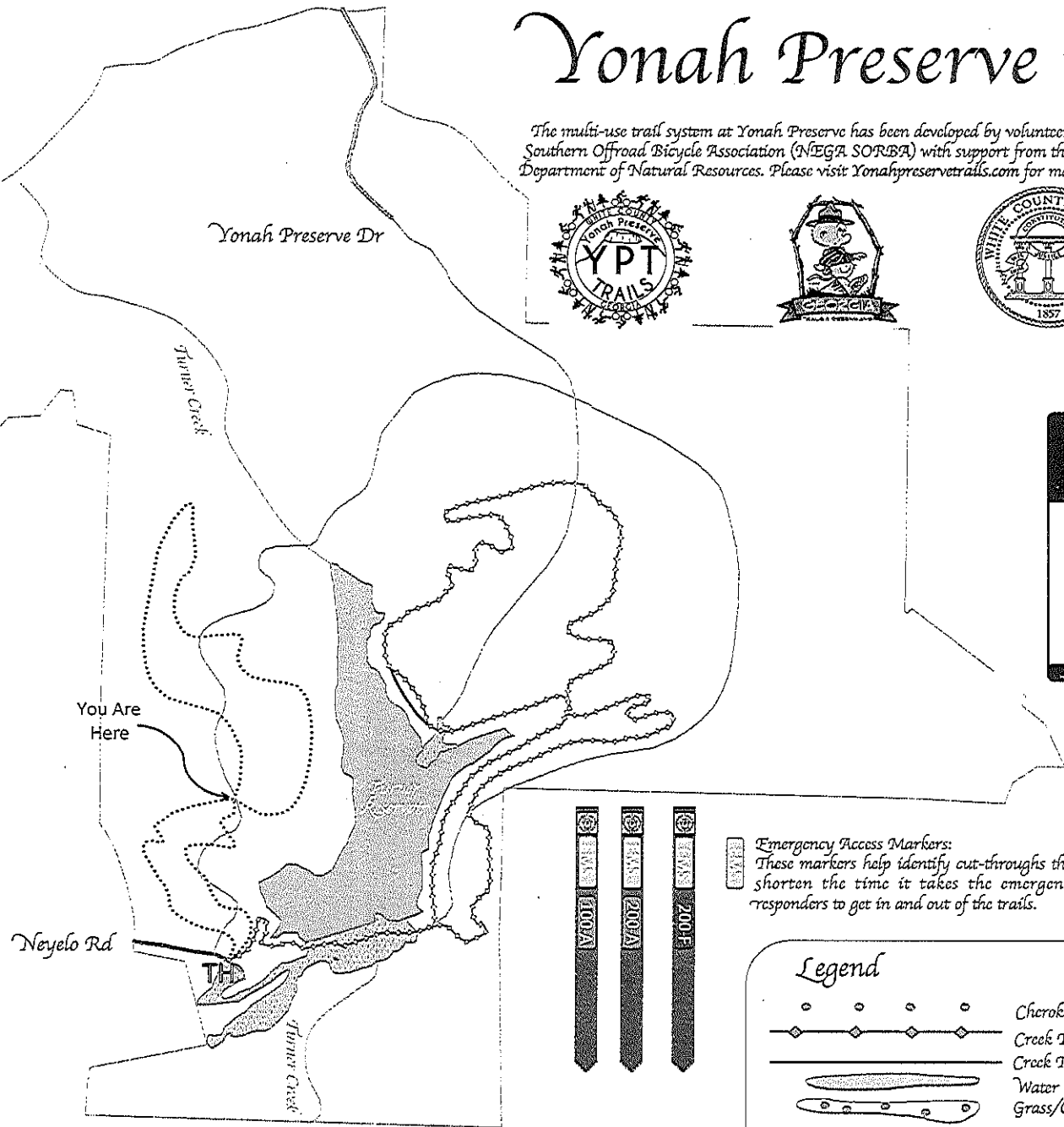

RULES OF THE TRAIL

- OPEN SUNRISE TO SUNSET
- STAY ON TRAIL, RESPECT PRIVATE PROPERTY
- KEEP RIGHT, PASS ON LEFT, HORN BEFORE PASSING
- NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES
- NO HORSES
- DOGS MUST BE LEASHED
- DOG OWNERS MUST PICK UP AFTER PETS
- DO NOT ALTER OR REMOVE PLANTS OR WILDLIFE



Emergency Access Markers:
These markers help identify cut-throughs that shorten the time it takes the emergency responders to get in and out of the trails.

Trail Number Markers:
These markers help you and emergency responders identify your location on the trails. In case of emergency please try to provide the nearest trail marker number to the 911 operator.
